Clinic Staffing

As there is a chronic shortage of Advanced Life Support paramedics (ALS) in South Africa and no equivalent qualification in the rest of Africa, RSMS is recommending the use Junior Doctors in the place of ALS paramedics. The Junior Doctor will fulfill a dual role at the site clinic. They will be available to respond to any emergency on site as part of the Emergency Medical Service as well as fulfill the "Doctor" role as part of the Primary Health Service and Occupational Health Service. The Junior Doctor will be supported by a qualified South African Intermediate Life Support paramedic (ILS).
